Scala Coeli, (Stairway to Heaven in Latin) takes its name from the Santa Maria Scala Coeli Monastery usually known as the Cartuxa Monastery where Carthusian monks live in silence and prayer. First produced in 2008, it is the result of the best varieties of each vintage, showing non indigenous grape varieties to the Alentejo. The current vintage (2011) is a varietal Sauvignon Blanc.

### Vinification

Produced from Sauvignon Blanc with grapes picked on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Comprehensive berry selection at the winery was followed by fermentation in stainless steel tanks with a further 12 months of lees ageing and stirring.
